WELCOME TO SODWANA BAY

Welcome to Sodwana Bay National Park, Zululand, a very unique place and the mecca of bill fishing in South Africa. Visitors need to be reminded that Sodwana Bay is approximately 190km (Richards Bay) from the nearest big city in a fairly remote part of Africa.

Whilst you will be allocated the best available comfortable accommodation and we have employed experienced chefs to prepare your meals, the accommodation is not a “hotel”. Teams will meet at a communal venue for meals and there is no “room service. (Tea/coffee/ drinks.) Rooms will, however, be cleaned and serviced daily.

Whilst cellular telephone communication is available, internet connection is unreliable and there is no free WIFI at the lodge. Remember you are in “the bush” and enjoy the experience.)

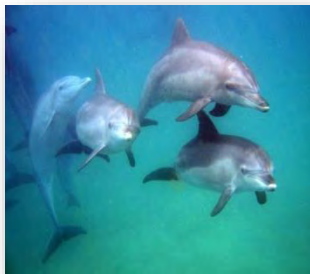
COMPETITION VENUE

Sodwana Bay National Park lies in the cultural heartland of Kwa Zulu Natal's far North Coast and is globally renowned for its bio diversity, both on land and below the ocean's surface.

You will discover kilometres of pristine unspoilt coastline which has been left unchanged from the fast-paced modern world with the sounds of bird and frog calls drowning out the sound of phone calls.

If you really want to get away from it all, Sodwana Bay is the perfect spot.

The spectacular coral reefs are amongst the southernmost tropical coral reefs in the world and the shallowest sighting of a living "fossil", the coelacanth was filmed and documented in the off-shore canyons.



The healthy coral reefs are home to over a thousand species of fish, invertebrates and coral and are situated in a national marine protected area, between Jesser Point in the south to Nine Mile Beach up north in the iSimangaliso Wetland Park, South Africa's first UNESCO World Heritage Site.

The Sodwana reef system may be a fraction the size of the Great Barrier Reef, but it is estimated to contain more than 2/3rds the amount of fish species. - 1200 in Sodwana as opposed to 1500. The coastline is largely undisturbed and natural migrations still occur with sightings of whale sharks, ragged tooth sharks, nesting turtles, whales, mantas and dolphin being reported at different times throughout the year.



While on land, Lake Sibaya which is South Africa's largest natural freshwater lake is situated 20km north of Jesser Point. On the surface, Lake Sibaya is a Ramsar site with a high bird count including the rare Pel's Fishing-owl, Cormorants, Kingfishers, Storks and the majestic Fish Eagle with its evocative call. The only population of the orchid *Vanilla roscheri* occurs near the lake, while another orchid, *Oecevelades decaryanum* was collected at the Lake for the first time in the country.

There are also resident populations of hippopotamus, crocodiles and the largest population of the freshwater goby - *Silhouetta sibayi*. Sodwana was named in the 19th century after the English Royal Navy landed at Jesser Point which was named after an English Officer.

Reportedly the landing party asked a group of Zulu women on the beach as to where they were, the Zulu women not understanding the foreign language thought they were asking if there was anyone else on the beach and they replied that they were alone. "Si" being the plural we and "odwa" being the term for alone or on its own. Sodwana Bay has developed relatively slowly in terms of global commercializing,

Increasing popularity with large numbers of South African fishermen and scuba divers in the late eighties and early nineties, saw the paving of the last 90 km stretch from Hluhluwe to Mbazwana which has made Sodwana accessible to all. Residents also offer numerous activities and services - including restaurants, scuba diving, guided tours, fishing charters and lots more.

How to join us at Sodwana:

By flight:

Arriving at OR Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg, you need to arrange a connecting flight to the King Shaka International Airport close to Durban.

By car:

After arriving at King Shaka International Airport close to Durban, follow the N2 North Motorway towards St Lucia. Turn right on the R22 towards Sodwana Bay.

During the event, in the proximity of the town, many directional marks will be put on the access roads to indicate the competition venue.

VERY IMPORTANT NOTES

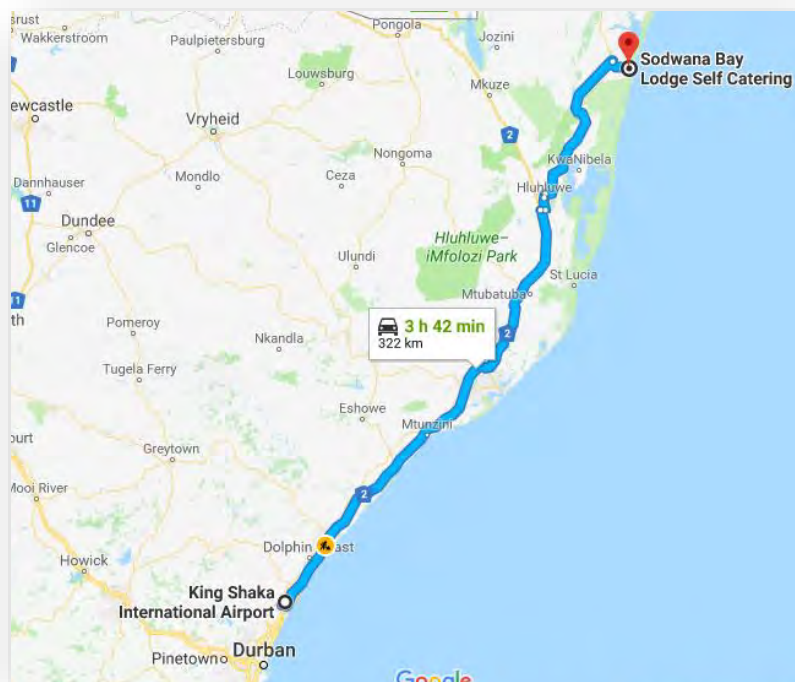
- *It is recommended that participants travel from their home countries to arrive at OR Tambo International airport, Johannesburg on Friday, February 8th 2019, book into their hotel/s for the nights of February 8th and February 9th Attend the Opening function of the World Angling Games on Saturday, and depart February 10th (Sunday morning after early breakfast) 6 am for Durban.*
- *Participants which will arrive first in Johannesburg on Friday, February 8th 2019, will have to pay the hotel accommodation for on February 8th and 9th 2019. The organizer will refund one night's accommodation fee of €29 (R 450,00) of Saturday, February 9th 2019 for these participants only.*
- *Team managers must communicate prior to the Championship with Big Game Local Organizer Secretary – Hymie Steyn via tel. 0027 21 9762714 or email. hymie_sadsaa@absamail.co.za to prevent double payment for accommodation for February 9th 2019.*

Teams must arrive in Durban not later than 11 am. From Durban, airport teams will be transported by bus to Sodwana Bay-370 km- 4 hours journey. On Sunday 17th February 2019, the return journey by bus to Durban will leave at 7 am from the Sodwana Lodge.

Arrival time Durban airport approximately 3 pm. For those participants who reserved a direct flight home from Durban may then check-in and enjoy the flight with happy memories. Other participants, departing from Johannesburg, may take a flight to Johannesburg and home.

BOATS

For the official training and during the competition, the organizer will supply boats boarding maximum 3 competitors, team captain plus the skipper and mate who will also be the Judge.

Boats with the South African team will also have a Judge from a different nationality.

Boat length ranges from 7.50 m to 12 m and cruise speed is of average 18 knots

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. For those attending the Opening Ceremony: On Sunday morning, 10th February 2019 teams must arrive in Durban not later than 10 am, From Johannesburg, they will travel by bus to Sodwana Bay (4 hours).
2. They will return from Sodwana Bay on Saturday morning, 16th February 2019 by bus after early breakfast (6 am) and then return home.
3. Breakfasts and meals will be served in the Marquee

WEATHER

The **weather in February in Sodwana Bay** is wet (with 117mm of precipitation over 14 days). It should be noted an improvement from the previous month since in January it receives an average of 183mm of rainfall over 18 days. The climate is quite comfortable in this location this month. Temperatures are up to 30°C. On average, the recorded minimum temperature is 26°C. Thus, the mean temperature average in February in Sodwana Bay is 28°C. On average, in Sodwana Bay, the days in February last 13:01 hours. The sun rises at 05:33 and sets at 18:34. With a **good climate**, this month is recommended to come to South Africa.

TOURNAMENT RULES

NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO DISCUSSION OR CHANGES OF RULES AT THE TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING

1. **FIPS-M Big Game rules will apply.** No change will be accepted. Not at the captain meeting nor before or during the competition.
2. **Baits & Lures:** Artificial baits may be used.
3. **Meal Hours:** Breakfast is served at the Marquee from 4.30. All anglers will be provided with daily boat packs to be collected after breakfast. Cold drinks, beer etc. for the day may be purchased from the Marquee at breakfast time.
4. **Fishing Hours:** Launch time will be 6.am. Lines in after Official start signal. Lines up 3 pm
Target species and points system as per the schedule displayed in this program.
5. **Minimum sizes:** The minimum size of a fish will be 750 mm.
6. **Boats:** Boats will be allocated on a rotational basis by a draw and no team will fish more than once from the same boat during the Tournament
7. **The standard of Boats:** Boats will on average be between 7m and 12m and fully equipped as required by the S.A. Department of Transport, S.A. Deep Sea Angling Association and FIPS-M.
8. **Skippers:** All boats will have a skipper and mate on board. The mate will act as judge.
9. **Rule Application:** All anglers are expected to respect the "Lines In", Lines Out" and closing times.
10. **Tackle Control:** Anglers must be prepared to submit tackle and lines for control purposes on request from the Tournament Director. Teams must consist of three (3) anglers plus the boat skipper and mate.
11. **Reserve:** The name of any reserve angler must be submitted to the Tournament Director on the evening before the next fishing day provided there was sufficient evidence that he is replacing a sick/injured angler.
12. **Angling licenses:** The organizers will obtain valid angling licenses for all participants.
13. **"Lines Up":** At "Lines Up" all rods must be removed from trolling boards or rod holders and stored inside the boat out of the view of passing boats. The standard practice of "Fish On" and "Lines up" must be followed. All other lines to be removed from the water and rods stowed in the event of a "Fish On" after "Lines Up"
14. **Jury:** The international Jury has the right to disqualify any capture following the examination and measurement of tackle and equipment used on the boat.

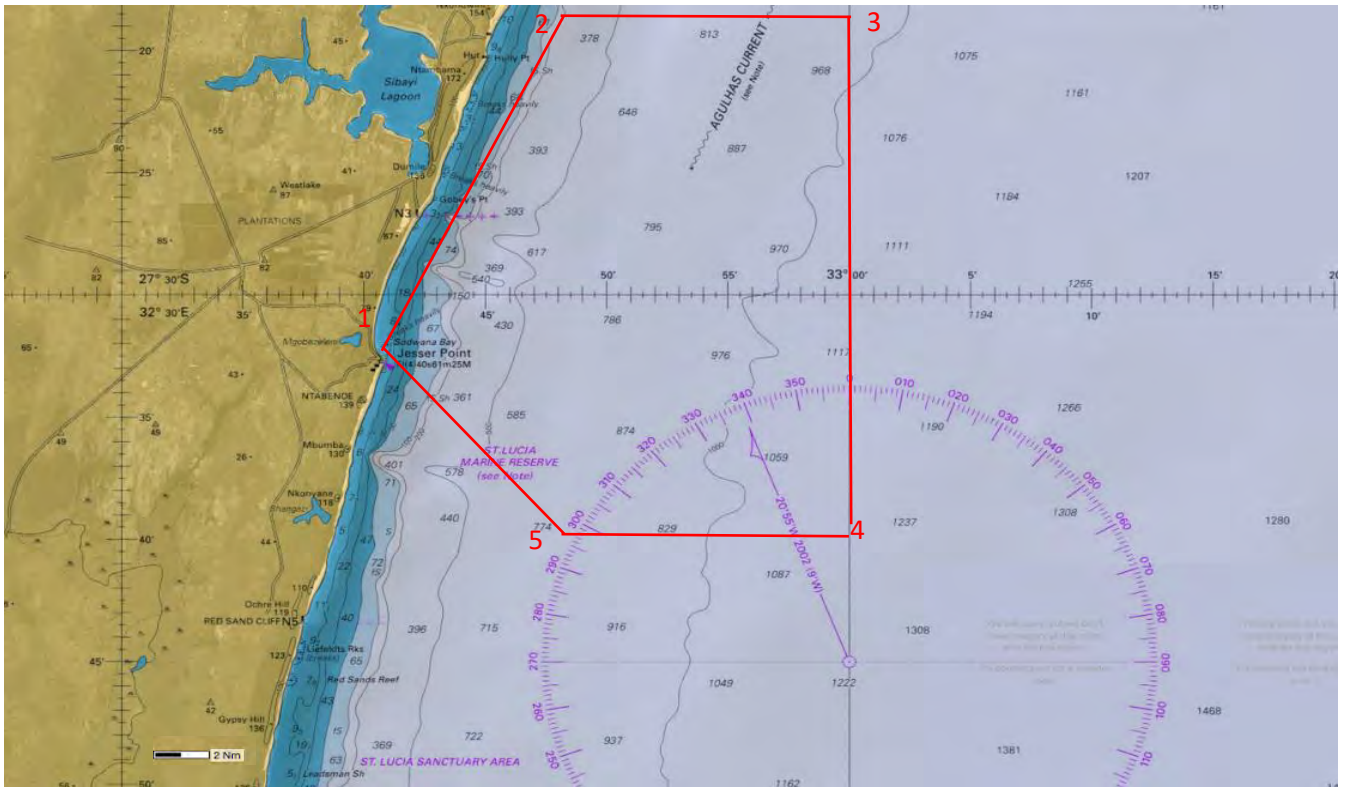
15. **Protests:** Any protest concerning the validity of the catch must be filled in writing, signed by the team and hand-delivered with the sum of € 100.00 (ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY FOUR RAND) to any member of the International Jury (who will be elected at the team captain's meeting) within one hour after the scales have closed. Protest Application forms will be available at the Weigh-in Station. The decision of the International Jury will be final.

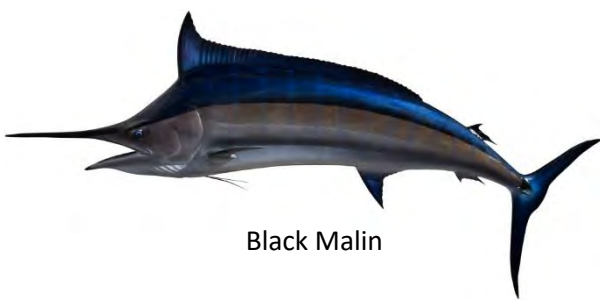
DEPTH CHART



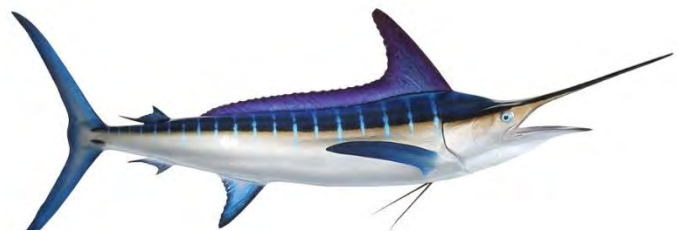
Fishing Area

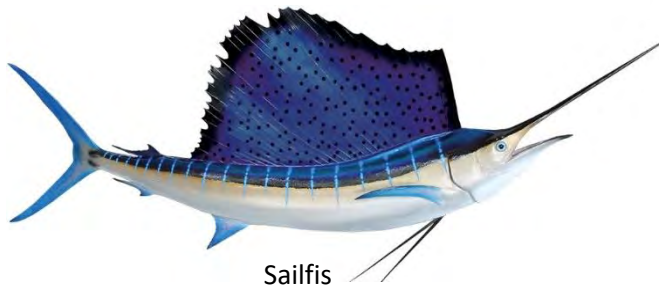

QUALIFYING FISH SPECIE & POINTS SCORING

BLACK- & BLUE MARLIN	50 POINTS
STRIPED MARLIN	30 POINTS
SAILFISH	20 POINTS
GAMEFISH	5 POINTS

QUALIFYING GAME FISH

All Tuna Species, Wahoo, Black Marlin, Blue Marlin, Stripped Marlin and Sailfish.

The minimum length for a gamefish to count will be 750mm from the nose to the fork of the tail.

In this regard, each boat will be issued with a floatable measuring stick (rod), attached to a rope which can be used to establish if the fish meets the minimum requirement. If the fish length is in doubt, the measuring stick is placed in the water next to the fish and the judge will determine if the fish may count.
