May this championship take place in the true spirit of sports competition, sports cooperation and friendship between our athletes, our federations and our peoples.



WHERE WE ARE AND HOW TO REACH US



HOW TO REACH US IN HAMMAMET

By plane:

From your country, the team must go to Tunis Carthage international airport or to Enfidha-Hammamet international airport.

By car:

The teams will be picked up by bus at one of the 2 international airports, at the agreed time to go to Hammamet (chargeable transport).

The teams who prefer to use their own vehicle to travel by road in the following directions:

- Either from Tunis-Carthage International Airport** (This route includes tolls)
 Take highway A1 and leave Boulevard du Leader Yesser Arafet and N9 (5 minutes = 3.3 km)
 Continue on the A1 highway towards Hammamet.
 Leave the A1 motorway (49 minutes = 67.5 km)
 Continue on Rue Chadly Mrad towards your destination (5 minutes = 1.4 km)
 Hotel Bel Azur Thalasso & Bungalows
 13 Avenue Ibn Fourat, Hammamet 8050
- Either from Enfidha Hammamet International Airport** (This route includes tolls)
 Take the A1 highway (6 minutes = 4.9 km)
 Continue on the A1 highway.
 Leave the A1 highway (33 minutes = 52.6 km)
 Continue on the Rue Chadly Mrad toward your destination (5 minutes = 1.4 km)

The city of Hammamet

Hammamet (in Arabic : **لحمّامات**) is a Tunisian city located northeast, on the southeast coast of Cape Bon, about sixty kilometers south of Tunis Capital.



It is one of the main seaside resorts in Tunisia.



Renowned since the second half of the XXth century, the city has long beaches along the Gulf bearing its name.



The nucleus of Hammamet is made up of its medina. To the west is the kasbah and, to the north, the Place des Martyrs where there is a monument resembling the Eiffel Tower and which recalls the martyrs of the War of Independence.

The tourist area is divided, from the center, into two sections. The smallest and oldest (Hammamet Nord) stretches towards Nabeul and the largest and most recent (Yasmine Hammamet), located a few kilometers to the west, stretches towards Bouficha. Three kilometers from the center is a cultural center which hosts the Hammamet International Festival every summer.

Several golf courses are close to the town.

REGISTRATION FEES FOR DELEGATIONS

The team will be composed of 5 competitors and a manager.

Competition costs per competitor belonging to a team or individually = 800 €.

Competition fees for captain or reserve or manager = 700 €.

Participation fees for accompanying persons = 600 €.

Teams are allowed to participate in the competition with 5 competitors: 800 € x 5 = 4000 €.

COST OF THE TEAM = 4700 €.

The following fees are included:

- a. The accommodation at the hotel in a double room with full board (breakfast, lunch or packed lunch, dinner) beginning on Saturday 28 November 2020 in the evening, and ending on Saturday 05 December 2020 with the breakfast.**
- b. Transport to and from the competition sites.**
- c. Round trip transportation for the opening ceremony and street parade.**
- d. The gala dinner of the closing ceremony.**
- e. Fishing baits for the 5 competitors (official training and 4 fishing days).**

- The price of tickets for the closing ceremony is 60.00 € per person.

- The price for round-trip airport-hotel transport is 60.00 € per person.

- The price for the round-trip hotel-training area transport (unofficial) is € 20.00 per person (minimum 04 people and to be specified 48 hours in advance).

We remind you that:

- A national team participating in this MASTERS championship must be composed of 5 fishermen or at least 4 fishermen.**
- For this MASTERS championship, a maximum of 2 national teams can participate.**
- Only competitors who will be 55 years old between January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020 will be able to participate in this World Championship for Masters.**

We also remind you that during the General Assembly of FIPS-M on May 3, 2019 some regulations were modified or adapted:

“In order to allow participation in small federations, which for lack of members cannot present an entire national team, **the Assembly decided to accept the individual participation of competitors.** The maximum number of individual participants allowed will be less than the maximum number of a team. **These individual fishermen count for the individual classification but not for the classification by nation or by team.**”

GENERAL INFORMATION

A. INSURANCE

The organizer undertakes to set up an insurance for civil responsibility.

B. MEDICAL CERTIFICATES AND MEDICAL STAFF

1. Each delegation is responsible for the data entered / provided for their team and ensures that all team members are able to participate in the competition.
2. The organizer will have competent medical staff for the duration of the competition.

C. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

All participants / competitors participating in the championships implicitly include acceptance of ALL of the AMA Sport Anti-Doping Rules.

D. VISAS

Visas will be no compulsory for all visitors. Contact your nearest Tunisian consular representative.

E. NATIONAL FLAG AND HYMN

The delegations are required to provide the organizer with at least one (preferably two) flag of their country (height 90 cm, width 120 cm), as well as a USB key with their national anthem in MP3 format.

F. MEDALS AND OTHER AWARDS

The winners will receive medals - gold, silver and bronze - from FIPS-M, while the organizer will offer cups and other commemorative prizes.

G. MEANS OF PAYMENT (CURRENCY)

The currency used is TND (Tunisian Dinar) but payments could be made in other valid convertible currencies (by exchange in banks or at the hotel reception).

The organizing committee will also provide delegations with a TPE (Electronic Payment Terminal) for payment by MasterCard or Visa card.

IMPORTANT: As soon as you enter Tunisian territory, you must declare to the customs of the airport the amounts in foreign currency that you brought with you.

H. BAITS

The following types of bait will be provided PER DAY and PER COMPETITOR:

- Demi-Dure (Grosse): 40 pieces
- Maddies (Chitana): 80 grams (about 140 pieces)
- Razor Fish (Calonica): 10 pieces

J. OTHER

- a. The minimum size for the common fish is set at thirteen (13) cm measured from the tip of the snout to the extreme end of the tail except for the exceptions listed in Appendix 2.

b. Only judges will be allowed to remove hooks from poisonous fish.

Example: The lesser weever (*Echiichthys vipera*) of the Trachinidae family.



c. The fish will be measured on the ground by a judge. The length and species of fish will be recorded on the competitors' correspondence card.



e. **Classification by Points "Catch and Release":**



- For each caught fish with legal size 10 points.
- For each centimetre (1 cm) 1 point.
- For each part of a cm is rounded up 1 point.
- No bonus point for fish that are not of legal size.
- The longest and number of fish must be recorded daily to be used in the case of a tie
- Only the steward is allowed to measure the fish. In the case of a dispute the FIPS-M delegate will make the final decision.
- The length is measured from the tip of the mouth to the end of the caudal fin on a flat surface (see the figure).


MINIMUM LEGAL SIZE OF FISH

The minimum size for the common fish is set at thirteen (13) cm measured from the tip of the snout to the extreme end of the tail except for the following exceptions:

- Fish that are not on this list, must have a minimum size of thirteen (13) cm.
- Are excluded from the list of valid catches : sardines and all species protected by Tunisian law. They must be returned to the water immediately alive and not mutilated if they were to be caught.

Only single hooks (any kind) are allowed and must have an opening (gap) of at least 5 mm. Any competitor using or being in possession of incorrect hooks during or after the competition will be disqualified.



K. FISHING STORE

There will be a fully equipped fishing shop on site at the Bel Azur hotel.

L. SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS

If a team wishes to arrive earlier for training or stay after the official competition, the organizer will provide the following price:

Full board accommodation, per person per day in shared room = **50 €**

Full board accommodation, per person per day in single room = **65 €**

ESSENTIAL ANTI-DOPING ADVICE

Athletes are reminded if they take any medication they must check it against the WADA Prohibited Substance & Methods list.

Particular attention must be paid to the use of anti- hypertensive agents, especially diuretics, which are popular in singular preparation and/or in a combination with other normally permitted drugs.

Diuretics are always forbidden.

For these reasons, it is necessary for every athlete or National Federation to check the list for prohibited substances and process a TUE as necessary. The Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) must be granted before taking a prohibited medication.

An application for a TUE must be requested 30 days before taking part in the championships. The application forms must be filled in carefully with your physician/doctor who must authorise the application. A physician's certificate or prescription on its own does not mean that the athlete has permission to use the prohibited substance or method.

The application should be completed either in English or French and sent directly to the office of the CIPS President.
