Tunisia is the rainbow nation of the world because of our different cultures and we invite you to share our hospitality and the natural beauty of our sites.



HOW TO REACH US IN HAMMAMET

By plane:

From your country, the team must go to Tunis Carthage international airport or to Enfidha-Hammamet international airport.

By car:

The teams will be picked up by bus at one of the 2 international airports, at the agreed time to go to Hammamet (chargeable transport).

The teams who prefer to use their own vehicle to travel by road in the following directions:

• Either from Tunis-Carthage International Airport (This route includes tolls)
Take highway A1 and leave Boulevard du Leader Yesser Arafet and N9 (5 minutes = 3.3 km)

Continue on the A1 highway towards Hammamet.

Leave the A1 motorway (49 minutes = 67.5 km)

Continue on Rue Chadly Mrad towards your destination (5 minutes = 1.4 km)

The city of Hammamet

Hammamet (in Arabic : לכה וֹבְּוֹב) is a Tunisian city located northeast, on the southeast coast of Cape Bon, about sixty kilometers south of Tunis Capital.





It is one of the main seaside resorts in Tunisia.





Renowned since the second half of the XXth century, the city has long beaches along the Gulf bearing its name.





The nucleus of Hammamet is made up of its medina. To the west is the kasbah and, to the north, the Place des Martyrs where there is a monument resembling the Eiffel Tower and which recalls the martyrs of the War of Independence.

The tourist area is divided, from the center, into two sections. The smallest and oldest (Hammamet Nord) stretches towards Nabeul and the largest and most recent (Yasmine Hammamet), located a few kilometers to the west, stretches towards Bouficha. Three kilometers from the center is a cultural center which hosts the Hammamet International Festival every summer.

REGISTRATION FEES FOR DELEGATIONS

The team will be made up of 5 competitors and a manager.

Fees for competitor (belonging to a team or individually) = 800 € per person.

Fees for captain and reserve = 700 € per person.

Teams are authorized to participate in the competition with 5 competitors: 800 € x 05 = 4000 €.

COST PER TEAM = 4700 €.

Included in the participation fees:

- a. Hotel accommodation in a double room with full board (breakfast, lunch or packed lunch and dinner) starting with dinner on Saturday, December 11, 2021 and ending with breakfast on Saturday, December 18, 2021.
- **b.** Transportation to and from competition venues.
- c. Round-trip transportation for the opening ceremony and parade (street parade).
- **d.** The closing ceremony gala dinner.
- e. Fishing baits for the 05 competitors (official training and 04 days of fishing)
- For the captain and the reserve: the participation fee is 700 € per person including the services a, b, c, and d above.
- For accompanying persons: the costs are 400 € per person including the services a, b, c and d above.
- The price for an additional gala dinner at the closing ceremony is 60.00 € per person.
- The price of return airport-hotel transport is € 60.00 per person (to be reserved before the delegation arrives in Tunisia).
- The price of the hotel-training area (unofficial) round trip is \in 20.00 per person (minimum 04 people and to be reserved 48 hours in advance).

We remind you that:

- A national team participating in this MASTERS championship must be composed of 05 fishermen or at least 04 fishermen.
- For this MASTERS championship, a maximum of 02 national teams can participate.
- Only competitors who will be 55 between January 1, 2021 and December 31, 2021 will be able to participate in this World Championship for Masters.

We also remind you that during the General Assembly of FIPS-M on May 3, 2019 some regulations were modified or adapted:

"In order to allow participation in small federations, which for lack of members cannot present an entire national team, the Assembly decided to accept the individual participation of competitors. The maximum number of individual participants allowed will be less than the maximum number of a team. These individual fishermen count for the individual classification but not for the classification by nation or by team."

GENERAL SAFETY RULES FOR FIPS-M CHAMPIONSHIPS

SELF-DECLARATION TO BE OBLIGATORILY COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY MEMBERS OF ALL DELEGATIONS THEN TO BE SENT BY EMAIL (masters.tunisia2020@gmail.com) WITH THE REGISTRATION FORM (SEE APPENDIX):

Signed **Covid-19 Self-declaration** form of each participant will be acquired by the Representative of International Federation present and 14 days after the championship, in compliance with the privacy regulation, it will be responsibility of International Federation to dispose them.

If the national or regional rules and directives are more stringent than the FIPS-M prescriptions, the directives of the country / place of the organization must be observed.

1. COVID MANAGER

The COVID manager of the 4th World Championship Shore Angling MASTERS - TUNISIA 2021 is the official doctor of the FTPS, **Doctor Mourad BEN TALEB (Telephone:** +21620750631).

2. CONTINGENCY PLAN

All participants should be tested for COVID-19 (level determined by national/local or regional safety policy), preferably under medical supervision before Registration. Latest the 5th day of the Championship there will be carried out an obliged COVID-19 Rapid test (up an agreement, costs for test kits may be borne by International Federation). Any positive cases to be immediately isolated and excluded from further participation. In the event of any team member/official testing positive then all contacts of that individual would have to self-isolate for 7+ days. If a positive case is detected within a team during the championship, then the team bubble is immediately put into quarantine (this effectively disqualifies the entire team from competition). In addition, all team members must be PCR tested and a contact tracing procedure is to be applied. As a preventive measure related symptoms (the body temperature above 37,5 Celsius, cough, cold, sore throat, difficulty breathing, shortness of breath, fatigue and muscle pain, abdominal pain, diarrhoea, loss of taste and/or smell) are to be immediately reported to Covid Manager, the effected person/s will be isolated and an appropriate medical intervention will be provided.

Within 14 days after returning home from the event, if any event participant shows COVID symptoms, and/or receives a positive test result he/she should immediately notify the event Organising Committee and along with details of his/her close contacts retrospectively during the event in order the contact trace procedure can be applied.

The costs related to the extension of the stay due to quarantine measures as well as any costs for health care are entirely borne by the persons involved.

3. HOTEL

The organizer/hotel must provide all necessary disinfecting materials in the hotel. The wearing of face covering is mandatory during the entire stay in common areas and restaurants except for the consumption of food and drink. Communal meals and drinks must be served and consumed at the table (**no** self-service buffet). Each team must have its own dedicated table for the entire duration of the event. Full compliance with the safety rules provided for restaurants, bars and hotels must be strictly followed. Team members must stay at the table for duration of meal in the restaurant. Packed lunches for competition days are to be provided. Only one dedicated person (ideally captain/manager) will come to collect the packed lunches in boxes for his/her whole team. After any excursion, each participant's temperature will be tested with an infrared non-contact thermometer before entering the hotel. **No** socializing among team residents in the hotel is allowed.

4. CAPTAINS' MEETINGS

A large room, with chairs placed at a social distance from other must be provided. The use of handheld / mobile microphones is not permitted. The distances between persons on the president's table should be at least 2 meters. To reduce the meeting time, the captains of each team must have previously checked and signed the list of their competitors' data and have declared their reserve. Only 1 captain per team is allowed to participate in the meeting (except

if he needs his own translator). The protective face covering is compulsory for all present and it is also compulsory to disinfect hands when entering the room, provided fluid shall be used. The results of the draw and the rankings will be made available to participants only via internet (to avoid excessive concentration of people, there will be no information board available). To minimize movement within a room, the organizer will perform the manual draw (if necessary) instead of the captains. A virtual captains' meeting is an option that may be considered by the national organizer and the FIPS delegates.

5. CEREMONIES

The use of handheld / mobile microphones is not allowed. Only static / fixed microphones are permitted and must be thoroughly disinfected before their use by individual speakers. During the ceremonies, whether they take place outdoors or indoors, it will be mandatory to wear a face covering and maintain a social distance between all participants. Ceremonies should be as short as possible.

For the **Opening Ceremony** a formal declaration of opening of the championship by FIPS delegates (and reading of the Olympic oath, if necessary) is required as a minimum. For the **Closing Ceremony** medals and the trophies will be placed on a table near the podium and each competitor, called, will take his/her medal and trophy before going to the podium. The disinfection of hands and exposed surfaces beforehand is strongly recommended.

6. SPECTATORS

All spectators must comply with host country/region COVID-19 regulations.

7. RULES FOR SHORE ANGLING

While distributing bait, members of the organization and captains must maintain a distance of at least one and a half meters from each other. Only 1 person per team (captain or vice-captain) will come to collect the bait. The use of a mask is compulsory. The organization will provide hand disinfection gel.

Outside his fishing area (peg) the competitor must wear a mask.

The competitor must go directly to his fishing area without coming into contact with other competitors. He may have recourse to the help of the captain for preparation before the start of the competition.

Only the captain, vice-captain or reserve can approach the angler up to a distance of one and a half meters. In the angler's area the use of the mask during the competition is optional. Controllers must be equipped with a protective visor (or FFP2 mask) and gloves to control the fish, either by measurement or by weighing (in the case of float fishing). The registration sheet will be presented to the angler for confirmation and signature, which will be done with a disinfected pen provided by the organization otherwise the competitor must use gloves. The competitor who does not respect these safety rules will be, after a first warning, disqualified for the round.

GENERAL INFORMATIONS

A. INSURANCE

The organizer undertakes to set up an insurance for civil responsibility.

B. MEDICAL CERTIFICATES AND MEDICAL STAFF

- **1.** Each delegation is responsible for the data entered / provided for their team and ensures that all team members are able to participate in the competition.
- 2. The organizer will have competent medical staff for the duration of the competition.

C. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

All participants / competitors participating in the championships implicitly include acceptance of ALL of the AMA Sport Anti-Doping Rules.



KEY RECOMMENDATIONS IN THE FIGHT AGAINST DOPING

Athletes who take medication are required to check whether these are on the list of substances and methods prohibited by WADA.

Special care should be taken when taking antihypertensive drugs, especially diuretics, which are available both as individual preparations and in combination with other normally authorized drugs. Diuretics are still prohibited.

For these reasons, each athlete or national federation must check the list of prohibited substances and, if necessary, request a therapeutic use authorization (TEU). The therapeutic use exemption must be granted before taking a prohibited substance.

The authorization for therapeutic use must be submitted 30 days before participation in the championships. Application forms should be completed carefully and with the permission of your doctor. A doctor's certificate or order does not in itself authorize the athlete to use the prohibited substance or method.

The application must be completed in French or English and sent directly to the office of the President of CIPS.

D. VISAS

E. CURRENT CONDITIONS OF ENTRY INTO TUNISIAN TERRITORY DURING THE GLOBAL COVID-19 PANDEMIC:

F. NATIONAL FLAG AND HYMN

The delegations are required to provide the organizer with at least one (preferably two) flag of their country (height 90 cm, width 120 cm), as well as a USB key with their national anthem in MP3 format.

G. MEDALS AND OTHER AWARDS

The winners will receive medals - gold, silver and bronze - from FIPS-M, while the organizer will offer cups and other commemorative prizes.

H. MEANS OF PAYMENT (CURRENCY)

The currency used is TND (Tunisian Dinar) but payments could be made in other valid convertible currencies (by exchange in banks or at the hotel reception).

The organizing committee will also provide delegations with a TPE (Electronic Payment Terminal) for payment by MasterCard or Visa card.

IMPORTANT: <u>As soon as you enter Tunisian territory, you must declare to the customs of the airport the amounts in foreign currency that you brought with you.</u>

J. SPECIES OF FISHMany fish species are caught in the region, but the predominant species are:

K. OTHER

a. The minimum size for any type of fish is set at twelve (12) cm measured from the tip of the snout to the extreme end of the tail.

Are excluded from the valid catches: sardines, molluscs, crustaceans and marine mammals. They must be returned to the water immediately alive and not mutilated if they were to be caught.

b. Only judges will be allowed to remove hooks from poisonous fish. Example: The lesser weever (*Echiichthys vipera*) of the Trachinidae family.



- **c.** The fish will be measured on the ground by a judge. The length and species of fish will be recorded on the competitors' correspondence card.




• For each caught fish with legal size 10 points.

• For each centimetre 1 point (1 cm = 1 point).


• For each part of a cm is rounded up 1 point.

- No bonus point for fish that are not the legal size (size less than 12 cm).
- The longest and number of fish must be recorded daily to be used in the case of a tie.
- Only the steward is allowed to measure the fish, in the case of a dispute the FIPS-M delegate will make the final decision.
- The length is measured from the tip of the mouth to the end of the caudal fin on a flat surface. For rays or skates, the width of the wings is measured (see figures).






This is the plan which describes the dimensions of the measuring lath.
