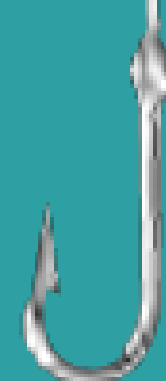

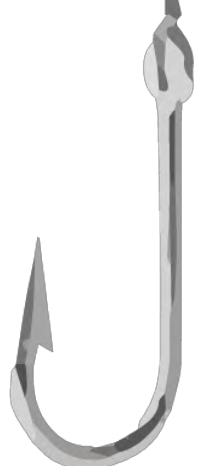
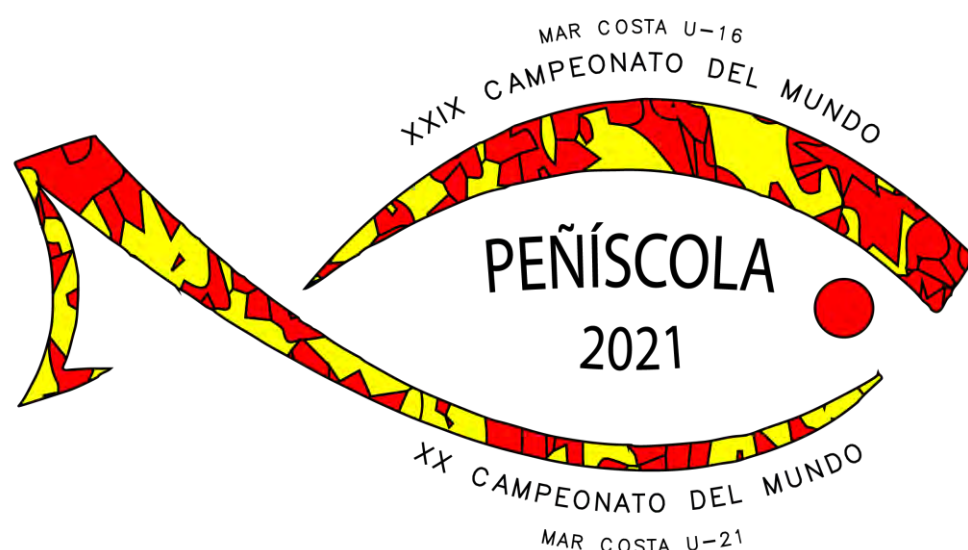

DISCOVER CASTELLÓN:

The province of Castellón covers the northernmost territory of the Valencian Community, along which a coastline of 120 kilometers of wonderful beaches extends, many of them have the Blue Flag granted by the Foundation for Environmental Education of Europe Beaches such as those of Peñíscola, Alcocebre, Oropesa, Benicassim, Castellón, Burriana or Almenara, give good faith of this.



El Fadri y la Concatedral de Santa María

One of the architectural characteristics of Castellón is that its bell tower, El Fadri, is separated from the city's Co-Cathedral, it was nicknamed this name because Fadri in Spanish means single.

It is a free-standing bell tower, octagonal with an approximate height of 60 meters. It is divided into four bodies, which inside correspond to the chamber of the clock, the prison of the ecclesiastic, the house of the bell ringer and the chamber of the bells. These four interior bodies do not correspond to the exterior cornice lines. At the top is a parapet, decorated with eight gargoyles.

The Co-Cathedral of Santa María and El Fadri are located in the main square.

Another must-see building in Castellón is the Basilica de la Mare de Deu del Lledó. According to legend, a farmer, "Perot de Granyana" found hooked in the plowshares of the plow, a small image, barely 6 centimeters high, of the Virgin. Thanks to this, that was the place chosen for the construction of the basilica.

Today, the Castellón society shows the pride of belonging to our town, which is exhibited in each celebration of our festivals, a pleasant place on the shores of the Mediterranean that the sun comes to illuminate an average of 300 days a year.



Peñíscola is one of our great attractions in the entire province. In addition to the Templar castle, the city has the walls that Felipe II commissioned to the Italian military architect Giovanni Battista Antonelli, who was the one who designed them, being built between 1576 and 1578. The Portal Fosc, also called Felipe II, is one of the three entrances to the historic center of Peñíscola; It was built in 1578 and its authorship is attributed to the architect Juan de Herrera.

The history of the Casa de las Conchas de Peñíscola tells us that in the 1950s, when the first tourists arrived, a married couple living in the city built the house and for the love that the woman had for the sea

They decided to cover the entire facade with shells that they exchanged, thus, they filled the facade with native shells of the area, they also endowed it with arabesque windows and with the coat of arms of the order of Papa Luna, symbols of the city of Peñíscola.

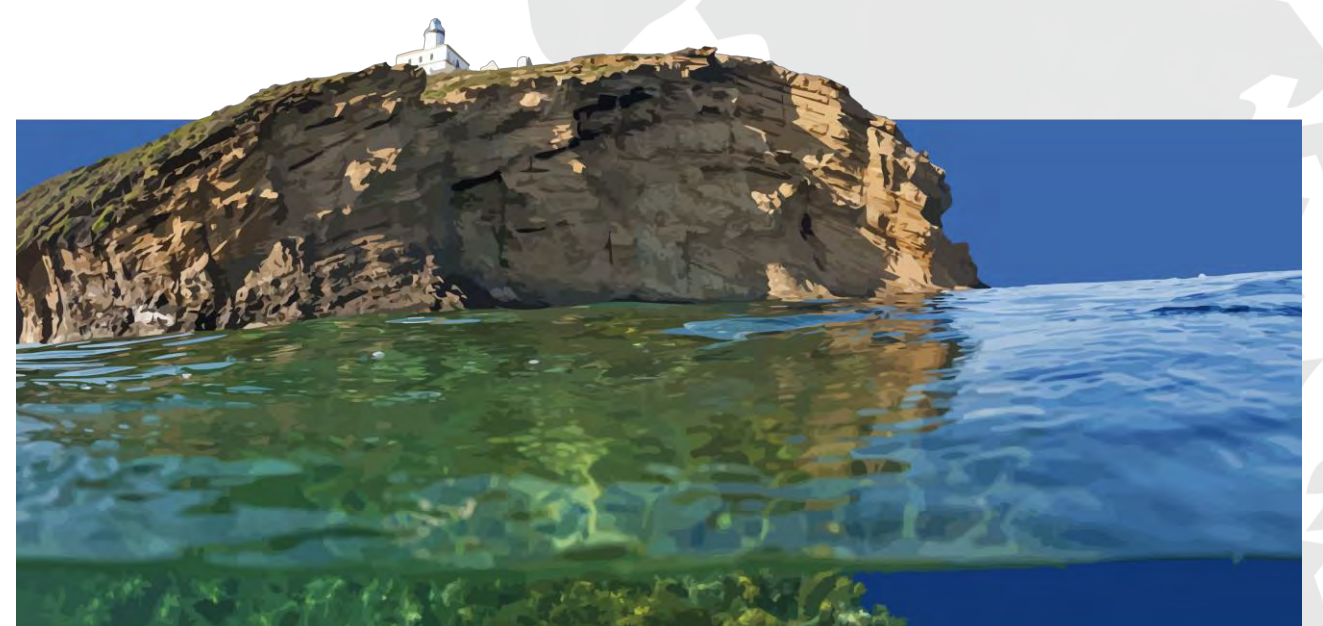
Las The Columbretes Islands are made up of a set of islets. The most important are: l'Illa Grosa (Columbrete Grande), la Ferrera (Perrera), la Foradada (Horada) and El Carallot (Bergantín).

The name Columbretes was given to it by the Romans when they realized the large number of snakes that lived there. Later they disappeared due to arson to kill them.

It is also worth mentioning that they represent a unique habitat throughout the Mediterranean, due to the great marine diversity that inhabits under its waters of species that would be difficult to find in other parts of said sea.



The Province of Castellón, despite being coastal, is the second most mountainous in Spain and in it is the Pico de Penyagolosa, which, with a height of 1,813 meters, is the roof of the Valencian Community.

In the northern part of the province is the region of Els Ports, whose capital is Morella, a medieval walled city, with an intense and important historical legacy.

There have been abundant remains of prehistoric art, such as the engravings and cave paintings of Morella la Vieja, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

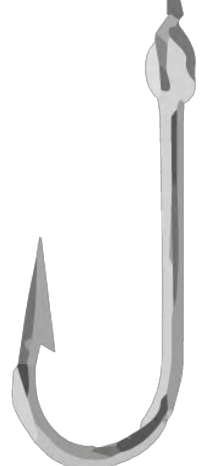


Last but not least, it is worth highlighting another natural park in the Sierra de Espadán, which feeds the longest navigable underground river in Europe, the San José de la Vall d'Uixó, with water, which can be enjoyed with a pleasant tour in boat.

The cavity called Coves de Sant Josep has been known and inhabited by humans for about 17,000 years. This is demonstrated by the archaeological sites found at its entrance, from paintings dating from the Magdalenian period to engravings in the rock. Sites declared a Site of Cultural Interest and UNESCO World Heritage.

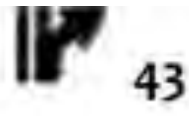
ACCESS TO PEÑÍSCOLA

Only the one supplied by the Organization is allowed and will probably consist of 6 boxes of beach worm and one of Korean.

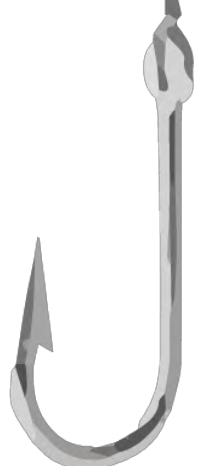
Anthem and Flag
